I was blessed with the perfect husband. FRANK MASTERSON, 30's, kisses Anne. Gets in car. Drives off. ANNE (V.O.) Anyone looking in thought I had it all.

Anne waves to neighbor. Gets in car. Jillian sits in passenger seat. Stares at phone. Anne drives off.

> ANNE (V.O.) This was my life.

7 INT. KITCHEN - NIGHT

> ANNE (V.O.) But there was a secret bubbling to the surface.

Anne sits in corner crying.

EXT. MASTERSON HOUSE - FRONT YARD - DAY

ANNE (V.O.) Each day I put on a mask for them.

Frank kisses Anne. Gets in car. Drives off.

ANNE (V.O.) Each day the mask cracked a little.

Neighbor waves at Anne. Anne sighs. Waves back. Gets in car. Jillian sits in passenger seat. Stares at phone. Smiles at Anne. Anne forces grin. Drives off.

9 INT. ANNE'S BEDROOM - CLOSET - NIGHT

> ANNE (V.O.) Each night it got closer and closer. It was only a matter of time till the flood gates burst.

Anne bawls up. Holds herself. Rocks. Stares at box in closet.

10 EXT. MASTERSON HOUSE - FRONT YARD - DAY

> ANNE (V.O.) This was not my life.

Frank move in to kiss Anne. Anne dodges. Hugs Frank. Frank gets in car. Drives off.

Neighbor waves at Anne. Anne gets in car. Jillian sits in passenger seat. Stares at Anne.

Anne drives off. Looks in rearview mirror. Frowns.

Anne grimaces. Rubs head. Moans.

KAREN (V.O.) Another headache?

ANNE Yeah, I'm tired.

KAREN (V.O.) You should see a doctor.

ANNE No thanks. Besides Sheri's stopping by later with a home remedy.

KAREN (V.O.) Your mom, Sheri.

ANNE

Yeah.

KAREN (V.O.) Alright... you coming in?

ANNE I should be there in an hour.

KAREN (V.O.)

Okay, bye.

Anne tosses earpiece on passenger seat. Turns on radio. Switches through channels. Sings along.

RADIO HOST (V.O.) That was the Capers with their latest hit. Someone's Love. (MORE)

- 23 EXT. MASTERSON HOUSE FRONT YARD -DAY 23 Sheri takes photo of Anne, Frank, and Jillian on porch.
- 24 INT. ANNE'S CAR BACK ROAD DAY 24 Anne yanks wheels. Breath hitches. Hits head on wheel.
- 25 INT. ANNE'S CAR SIDE OF ROAD DAY 25 Steam billows from engine. Blood drips from head Anne's head.
- 26 EXT. ANNE'S CAR SIDE OF ROAD DAY 26 Radio blast 90's song. Anne looks around. MAN 1 beats on car window. Anne jerks.

MAN 1 You okay?

Anne shakes head.

ANNE (whispers) Please.

MAN 1 Hey... Hello.

Man 1 yanks at door handle.

MAN 1 Can you hear me?

Anne covers eyes.

ANNE (whispers) Stop. MAN 1 Can you open the door? (beat) Hold on, I'll be right back. Man 1 runs to his car. 27 FLASHBACK - INT. HALLWAY - DAY Family photos and artwork hang on walls. YOUNG ANNE SMITH, 16, walks through hallway in tears. MARY SMITH, 40's, runs up stairs. ANNE Leave me alone. MARY Don't walk away from me. YOUNG ANNE You can't stop me from seeing him. HARVEY SMITH, 40's, pokes head into hallway. HARVEY What's going on? YOUNG ANNE She says I can't see Devin. HARVEY We were supposed to talk to her together. YOUNG ANNE You're taking her side. Why are you doing this to me? MARY It's not about sides, Annie. Harvey walks to Anne. Takes her shoulders. HARVEY I'm taking your side. It's my job to protect you. Young Anne shrugs Harvey's hands off her.

YOUNG ANNE You don't understand. Dad, please don't do this.

MARY Annie, your father and I just want to keep you safe.

YOUNG ANNE This isn't about me. It kills you too see anyone else happy.

Anne walks in room. SLAMS door.

28 EXT. ANNE'S CAR - SIDE OF ROAD - DAY (BACK TO PRESENT) 28

Man 1 runs to Anne's car with tire iron. Bangs on window.

MAN 1 I'm going to break the window, okay. Slide over.

Man 1 raise arm. Anne cranks car.

ANNE (V.O.) I had to go home. I needed to be with them before... they disappeared.

MAN 1 Hey. HEY, what are you doing?

Anne backs up. Man 1 falls. Anne speeds off.

Ass.

29 INT. MASTERSON HOUSE - ANNE'S BEDROOM - DAY

Sheets hang off bed. Nightstand and dresser drawers open. Clothes, and papers thrown about room.

Anne pulls boxes out of closet. Rifles through boxes. Pulls out photo. Falls. Cries.

30 INT. MASTERSON HOUSE - FOYER - DAY 30

Coat rack and table sit by front door. Framed photo of Anne and family sits on table.

Anne runs down stairs. Stops. Stares a photo. Smashes photo. Runs out.

ANNE (V.O.) This was all a lie.

31 INT. MASTERSON HOUSE - LIVING ROOM - DAY

Glass surrounds front table. Family photo lies on floor.

SHERI GREYSON, 50's, athletic, greying, enters with rolling pin in hand.

SHERI (yells) Annie. Jilly... anyone home?

FRANK MASTERSON, 30's rushes down stairs.

FRANK You're not going to need that Martha.

Sheri lowers rolling pin.

SHERI You checked the whole house.

Frank nods. Sheri sits rolling pin on couch.

SHERI (CONT'D) What happened?

FRANK I don't know, this is how Jillian found the place.

SHERI Where is she, is she okay.

FRANK She's with Karen.

SHERI Why didn't you call me sooner? I'm her grandmother.

FRANK Karen was already here.

SHERI

This is why you can't be so damn cheap when it comes to security. (long beat) Why was she here?

FRANK

Looking for...

Sheri cuts Frank off.

SHERI Annie, where's she? I talked to her this morning. Is she okay?

FRANK She's not answering her phone.

SHERI

Let me try.

Sheri pulls out phone. Dials. Puts phone on speaker.

SHERI (CONT'D) She'll pick up. She always answers my calls.

Phone rings. Voice mail answers.

ANNE (V.O.) You have reached Anne Masterson. I am not available to take your call. If this is one of my clients and this is an emergency call 911 immediately. If this is one of my monkeys, I'll call back as soon as I get your message.

BEEP.

SHERI Something's wrong, she always answers.

Sheri dials. Message starts. Hangs up.

FRANK I think she was here when...

SHERI She's fine! She'll walk though that door any minute with some crazy story about how she forgot to charge her phone. (MORE) SHERI (CONT'D) And ran out of gas. Or how she couldn't find her red scarf and knocked over the photo.

FRANK

Sheri.

SHERI You know how clumsy...

FRANK Sheri, there's blood.

SHERI This isn't happening. She'll walk through the door and we'll laugh.

FRANK The police are on the way.

32 EXT. MASTERSON HOUSE - FRONT YARD - DAY

Sheri paces in front of house. Puts phone up to ear.

SHERI (mumbles) Damn it, answer the phone. (beat) Annie, listen to me. It's momma. Come home, Annie.

Frank steps outside.

FRANK They'll be here soon.

Sheri whips around. Glares at Frank.

SHERI This is your fault. You're were never the kind of man my baby deserved.

FRANK

I don't like you, never have. I've put up with you for Anne. But right now I'm willing to put everything aside, to bring her home. Are you?

Sheri stares at Frank.

SHERI

Truce.
